RIGHT IN TOWN

1. Pick up visitor maps and guides from the Visitor Centre and find out all about Brunswick's Simple Pleasures from the friendly volunteer team.
2. Enjoy fresh local seafood from I'm a Catch. Pick up at Reflections Ferry Reserve on Saturday mornings.
3. Take home beautiful homewares or gifts from Saffron Home Essentials, Bruns Post Office or the Visitor Centre.
4. Have a coffee, breakfast, lunch or dinner at the pub, Footbridge, Sticky Fingers, Dolphin Café, Brunz Indian, Yami, Bernardi's Gelato, In The Pink, Saint Marie's, Old Maids, Bruns Bakery, BK's or walk over the footbridge to Rosafina's.
5. Stock up the pantry or picnic hamper at the IGA Supermarket or Brunswick Health Foods.
6. Fossick for vintage and retro treasures in Resould, Valiant Music, Miss Brown's Vintage, Op Shops and the Old and Gold Festival on the June long weekend.
7. Shop for a Brunswick Heads souvenir towel, t-towel, t-shirt and check out range of made in Bruns inspired merchandise at the Visitor Centre.
8. Enjoy a drink in the beer garden at the Hotel Brunswick or catch a show at the Brunswick Picture House.
9. Pick up a newspaper or magazine at the Post Office or Ampol, or a secondhand novel from the Visitor Centre.

FORGET THE CAR AND USE YOUR LEGS

10. Do a walking tour of the town with your free map from the Visitor Centre.
11. Amble to the end of the breakwall or get up early and watch the sunrise.
12. Walk your dog along the beautiful beach south of the Surf Club.
13. Take a stroll along the foreshore and over the highway bridge to the Nature Reserve on the north side and along Oyster Lease Rd.
14. Grab an Historical Walks map from the Visitor Centre.

BE A SPECTATOR

15. Watch the boats come in and out of the bar and spot dolphins and whales from the Brunswick breakwall early at dawn and dusk in season.
16. Take a personal tour of the Marine Rescue Tower and learn about the dangers of the bar and the history of the shipwrecks.

19. Take in the breathtaking views over Bruns and beyond from the Ocean Shores lookout at Devine's Hill.

23. Enjoy fish n chips overlooking the river at Hotel Brunswick.
24. Play Bingo on Monday, Trivia night on Tuesday or enjoy a game of barefoot bowls on Sunday at the Brunswick Bowling Club.
25. Pitch a tent at one of our three riverfront Reflections Holiday Parks – Terrace Reserve, Massy Greene or Ferry Reserve.
26. Picnic or BBQ in the parks and kick a ball or throw a frisbee.

38. Head out on a whale watching cruise (in season) with Wild Bryon or Out of the Blue Adventures out of Brunswick Heads. If heading to Byron try Byron Bay Whale Watching.
39. Join a stand up paddle tour of the Brunswick River with Let's Go Surfing. Or if in Byron with Cape Byron Kayaks. Pick up a brochure or paddle/canoe book at the Visitor Centre.
40. Go Snorkelling with Wild Byron or whale watching in season. Ask them about their beautiful rainforest tours too!
41. Swim between the flags at our patrolled surf beach to avoid rips.
42. Learn to surf like a local with Let's Go Surfing.

53. Ride your skateboards, bikes and scooters at the Bruns Skatepark.
54. Join in story time at the Library on Monday mornings at 10.30am.
55. Enjoy nostalgic rides and stalls at McGregor's Family Carnival in Banner Park in December and January.
56. Treat the kids to a delicious gelato at Bernardi's or In the Pink.
57. Try the trapeze and other circus fun with Circus Arts Byron Bay.
58. Discover Crystal Castle and Shambhala Gardens. A magical place of giant crystals, sacred statues, stunning gardens, unique jewellery, fresh food. Kids can now sit inside the Dragon's Egg crystal cave.
